



# EXHIBITING ARTIST APPLICATION

The Carco Theatre invites professional or amateur artists working in a variety of media to apply for consideration for the Carco Theatre Lobby art display. Local artists' exhibits are scheduled for six week periods. The Lobby has approximately 72 linear feet of wall space, with a picture rail and cable gallery system, and an additional 14' of space for works on paper to be hung with magnets.

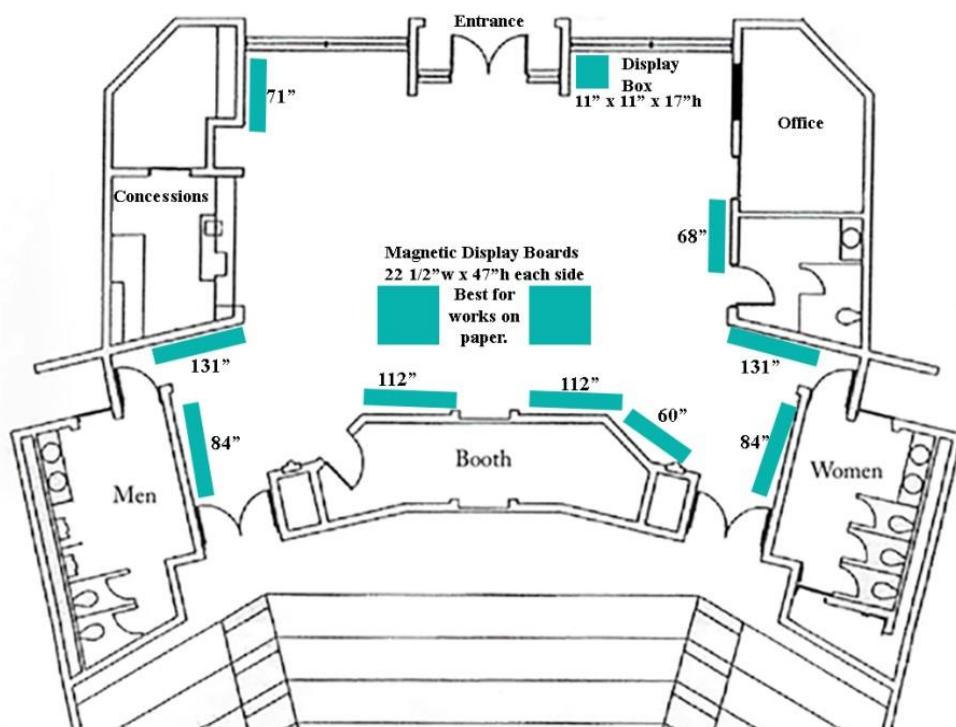
Review of applications is ongoing and accepted throughout the year. Interested artists will need to submit the following for consideration:

- A completed Artist Application Form
- An artist's display history/resume
- An artist biography and/or statement
- Five (5) high resolution JPEG images submitted either through e-mail or on CD with titles and descriptions provided

The Carco Theatre will base its selection of artists on the samples provided at the time of application, and artists will be expected to present similar works of art during their exhibit. Upon selection, artists are responsible for transporting, installing and labeling of artwork. No adhesives that leave a residue will be allowed on the walls. Carco Theatre will handle any sales, and will pay the artist their portion of the sales (80%) at the end of the exhibit. Artists need to provide title cards (with price) and/or a price sheet with all pertinent information for the artwork, and an 8.5 x 11 artist statement or biography.

The Carco Theatre will submit a press release and 3 images of the artist's choice to the media to promote the exhibit, will post images throughout the exhibit on our social media accounts, and will have an exhibit presence on our website.

The artist has the opportunity to schedule an evening reception from 5pm - 7pm during the exhibit dates assigned. The artist is entirely responsible for providing any foods or drinks for guests. Carco will sell wine and beer, but no alcoholic beverages are to be served for free. While the Carco Theatre will do its best to promote this event, it is the artist's responsibility to make it a success.
