- ► Make recommendations concerning funding for design improvement activities; and
- ► Review and make approval recommendation on downtown façade improvement grants.

The Design Committee works to enhance the attractiveness of the business district. Building rehabilitation, street and alley clean-up, colorful banners, hanging flower baskets, and lighting all improve the physical image of the downtown as a quality place to shop, work, walk, invest in, and live.
