A complaint should include:

- The address, telephone number and email of the person making the complaint
- 2. A clear description of the nature of the alleged violation

A Business Trespass Authorization form will authorize the police to go on the property, on the owner's behalf, and remove any unwanted individuals that have no legitimate purpose to be there. Security Surveys. The Renton Police Department offers free crime prevention surveys to enhance business security. A crime prevention specialist will visit your business to conduct the survey and will provide recommendations to make your business less attractive to criminals. The security survey may include recommendations about locks, lighting, security systems, doors, windows, cash handling procedures and Crime Prevention Through Environmental Design (CPTED).
